



Poll of 351 Illinoisans conducted by Illinois Public Opinion, Inc. between March 2-6, 2023. +/- 5% MOE








Do you support or oppose legislation that would allow licensed Illinois pet stores to sell dogs and puppies which have first received physical and dental exams by licensed veterinarians?



When asked, Illinoisans who are familiar with pet stores have strongly favorable opinions and believe Illinoisans should have the ability to obtain pets from licensed stores.



When asked, Illinoisans are split on their opinion of whether animal shelters should be allowed to purchase from puppy mills, suggesting a lack of awareness of the "retail rescue" cycle in which shelters keep puppy mills in business.
